**11-PLUS SCHOLARSHIP EXAMINATIONS**  
**FOR SEPTEMBER 2010 ENTRY**  
**SCHOLARSHIP DAY – MONDAY 8<sup>TH</sup> MARCH 2010**

**11+ Scholarship**

These examinations are particularly suited to children who may need to be prepared for Public School or Grammar School entry examinations and / or Common Entrance at the age of 13+.

Children who demonstrate outstanding ability and enthusiasm in any of the following areas are invited to sit Scholarship exams:

**ACADEMIC – SPORT – MUSIC – DRAMA – ART**

**Examination Details**

Scholarship exams comprise verbal/non-verbal reasoning tests, a reading and writing test, a numerical test and a discussion with the Scholarship panel about an area of particular interest or aptitude that the applicant may have. Separate tests are held for children showing outstanding potential in Art, Drama, Music or Sport (particularly Football, Rugby, Cricket, Netball, Tennis and Swimming). Other abilities are also be taken into account, e.g. potential / interest in Chess, General Knowledge, Foreign Languages, etc.

Successful Candidates will be advised in writing as soon as possible after 8<sup>th</sup> March but in any case by 19<sup>th</sup> March 2010. The decision of the Scholarship panel will be binding. Should a Scholarship be awarded, there is no obligation whatsoever to accept it but any award not accepted by 2<sup>nd</sup> April will be offered to another candidate.

**How to Enter**

Simply complete the Claremont School Scholarship Application Form and return it to the school by **Friday 26<sup>th</sup> February 2010** (sooner if possible).

**ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF AWARDS TO WHICH PARENTS MUST AGREE BEFORE ACCEPTING THE AWARD.**

1. Termly fees due, less any award made and accepted, must be paid on time as agreed with the school.
2. If a child who benefits from a Scholarship is withdrawn before taking the 13+ Common Entrance Examination, all scholarship monies received will be refundable in full prior to the child leaving Claremont.
3. The results of term work and examinations must be at a level similar to or better than those achieved in the successful scholarship examination.
4. The LEVEL of award is a strictly confidential matter between the parent and Claremont School and should not be discussed with or disclosed to any other party at any time.
5. High standards of behaviour are expected from all pupils at all times, including the utmost respect for other people and property.

**The Principal reserves the right to withdraw an award if any of these conditions are not fulfilled.**

**All applications will be dealt with in the strictest confidence and no contact will be made with the applicant's existing school, where applicable, until a Scholarship award has been made and accepted.**
