INFORMATION



FLIGHTS

Claremont is within easy access of all London airports. Flights should be arranged by the families.

All transfers will be coordinated by the School.

We advise that inbound and outbound flights should be between 10.00am- 18.00pm.

Transfer costs will be provided on application depending on arrival times and numbers in the group.

TRAIN

Battle Station is on the main line from London and is close to the boarding facilities (journey time is 75 minutes).

CAR

Students may also be dropped off by car.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Should be arranged by families.

POCKET MONEY

Students will require pocket money as there will be both full day and half day trips as part of the Summer School programme. Both boarding houses are close to local amenities, so students will also have the chance to visit nearby shops during their stay. We ask that all pocket money is handed in to the residential team on arrival. The team will then distribute as required.

PAYMENT

Claremont Summer School 2026 will take place from 5th July to 18 July & 19th July to 1st August.

Each two-week course will cost £2,495 excluding flights, and travel insurance. Transport to and from international airports available. Prices available upon request and dependent on numbers travelling. Places are limited.

A Deposit of £750 will be required at time of booking (full payment required 10 weeks before the start of the course).

Application deadline: 30th May 2026.



LENGTH OF STAY

The majority of students will sign up for one of the two-week courses; however, they are very welcome to stay for more than one course.

Students may also come for one or three weeks.

However, for those students travelling outside of the start and end dates of the two-week courses, there will be additional costs involved. Should you want to discuss this as an option, please email or call the Summer School Office.
